NIGHTS IN CUSCO



ITINERARY

DAY 01: IN CUSCO

Arrival, reception and transfer to the chosen hotel.

Free day for acclimatization.

Overnight in Cusco.

DAY 02: CUSCO CITY TOUR + ARCHEOLOGICAL PARK (B)

Breakfast.

At 12:30 hrs we will start our tour of the City of Cusco. We will visit the Plaza Mayor where most of the constructions preserve the colonial style. Then, we will visit the Qoricancha Temple, the highest expression of Inca architecture, currently the Santo Domingo Convent. Next, we will visit the Cathedral of Cusco, characterized by its Renaissance and colonial style. Finally we will visit the four archaeological centers surrounding Cusco: Sacsayhuaman, Qenqo, Puca Pucara and Tambomachay. Return to your hotel.

Overnight in Cusco.

DAY 03: SUPER SACRED VALLEY OF THE INCAS (B,L)

Breakfast. 06:30 to 07:00 hrs pick up passengers from hotels in Cusco. We will begin the tour with a visit to Chincheros, a small Inca and colonial town where typical ancient textiles are still made. Then you will visit Maras, where the most important salt mines in the region are located and it was the first salt producing center in the southern part of the mountain range. Later you will pass through the formidable archaeological complex of Moray, made up of admirable terrace systems, of enormous terraces that overlap concentrically, taking the shape of a gigantic amphitheater, these beautiful terraces formed a large agricultural laboratory where the ancient Peruvians achieved an incredible advance in the agriculture. The visit will continue until we reach

Ollantaytambo, one of the last Inca towns, and we will tour the wonderful archaeological complex located there. You will also have a delicious buffet lunch.

In the afternoon you will visit the archaeological complex of Pisaq, a place where you will appreciate the Inca terraces, and visit the typical artisan market. Return to your hotel in Cusco. Accommodation in Cusco.

DAY 04: MACHU PICCHU (B,L)

Breakfast. We will go to the Poroy or Ollantaytambo train station according to the season, where we will depart by train to visit one of the 7 Wonders of the World. We will arrive at the station of the town of Machu Picchu, where our staff will assist us to board the transport that will ascend an intricate path, giving us a spectacular view of the Urubamba River that shapes the famous canyon. The Lost City of the Incas, Machu Picchu, will welcome us with its incredible terraces, stairways, ceremonial precincts and urban areas. The energy emanating from all over the place. After a guided tour, we will have lunch at one of the restaurants in the area. At the appropriate time, we will take the train to take us to Ollantaytambo and then move to the city of Cusco. Overnight in Cusco.

DAY 05: HUMANTAY LAGOON (B,L)

04:00 hrs to 4:30 hrs Start of the tour and pick up from your respective hotel. With the guide, you will continue until you reach the town of Mollepata, where you will enjoy breakfast. In the course you will arrive at Soraypampa, where you will have a short rest and then continue with the walk to the Humantay Lagoon, which is located at an altitude of 4250 m.a.s.l. This ascent lasts approximately 1hr 30min, upon reaching the Humantay lagoon you will have enough time to appreciate the majestic lagoon that nature offers us. Also, there will be a brief demonstration of the payment to the land to the sacred Apus. At the appropriate time, you will return to Soraypampa and then to the town of Mollepata to enjoy lunch. Return to the city of Cusco, at approximately 18:30 hrs or 19:00 hrs. Transfer to your hotel.

Accommodation in Cusco.

DAY 06: RAINBOW MOUNTAIN (VINICUNCA) (B,L)

At 4:00 hrs I pick up passengers and transfer to the foothills of the Nevado Ausangate to start the tour to the 7 Colors Mountain. We will make a stop in the town of Cusipata to have breakfast. After a short talk we will start the 3-hour walk with a professional guide. Along the way we will learn about the different customs and the mysticism that the Andean mountain range hides. On the way back we will return to the town of Cusipata for the respective lunch. Return to your hotel in Cusco at 16:30 hrs.

Overnight in Cusco.

DAY 07: OUT CUSCO (B)

Breakfast. At a coordinated time, transfer to Cusco Airport to board the flight with return to the city of Lima or the country of origin.

RESERVATION CONDITIONS

This package does not represent a valid reservation. Reservations must be expressly requested. This package is subject to availability and price adjustments due to availability.

Rates are reconfirmed at the time of booking.

In 4* and 5* hotels, triple rooms (TPL) are not recommended since they are made up of a Double room + Additional Bed, sofa bed or RollAway.

Accommodation rates exempt from sales tax (IGV 18%). To make this exemption effective, passengers must register at the hotel with their original passport with migration stamp and with the Digital Andean Card duly stamped by migration. The identity card is valid only if the passengers come from countries belonging to the MERCOSUR treaty and Affiliated States.

Shared services (SIB or SIC) include guidance in Spanish or English, and bilingual guidance may be offered in some services.

Shared service excursions (SIB or SIC) require a minimum of 2 passengers.

A release is granted in a single room from 25 paid participants, maximum 1 release per group. (not valid for airfares, airport taxes, Hiram Bingham train service).

It is essential to present the passport to board all flights.

We need the complete itinerary of the flights and their locator record (PNR). Without this information we will not be able to solve any problem caused by changes in the flights by the airline.

RESERVATION POLICY

Due to the policies of the providers, we require:

Individual: complete data of the passengers 31 days before the start of services.

Groups: Preliminary List of passengers 60 days before the arrival of the group.

PAYMENT POLICY

The full payment must be made prior to the entry of the passengers according to the following deadlines:

Individual: 30 days before the start of services.

Groups: 60 days before the beginning of services (50% of the total amount), 30 days before (50% of the total amount).

You can require deposits or prepayments for non-conventional programs or during special events or policies of the providers. The agency shall immediately.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Individuals: With less than 30 days, expenses could be charged depending on the policies of our providers.

Groups: No cancellation fee up to 60 days before the arrival of the passengers. From 59 to 30 days before the arrival of the group, a 30% cancellation fee will be charged. From 29 to 15 days before the arrival of the group, a 50% cancellation fee will be charged. Less than 15 days before the arrival of the group, 100% cancellation fees will be charged. BILLING POLICY
